

GrePPP

The project was approved for seedmoney from Interreg Central Baltic May 23th 2017. It plans to develop and test criteria for sustainable public procurement of pharmaceuticals (SPPP) that are relevant for the aquatic environment and applicable under the relevant EU regulation, such as Public Procurement Directive, pharmaceutical regulation. Many national, subnational and international processes have been initiated to develop sustainability criteria for SPPP. Coordination between initiated national and international processes to develop sustainability criteria for SPPP is needed to avoid in-coherence in development of the criteria as well as to ensure effectiveness of their implementation. The project duration is 19 months.

Apart from Interreg Programmes, the partnership is also considering applying for BONUS, NEFCO and HORIZON 2020 Programmes. Combination of funding sources is also taken into consideration.

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
